



Live Ladybugs

Buy them *only* when you have aphids!



1. Water your garden before releasing your ladybugs
2. Release the ladybugs after sundown, because they don't fly at night. If released during the day, they will immediately fly away
3. Shake them out of the bag in groups at the base of plants or trees that have aphids (ladybugs always crawl *up*)
4. Always keep ladybugs out of direct sunlight, and as cool as possible. They may even be refrigerated down to 40° F; they hibernate at 35-40° F

****Note:** Tagawa usually carries live ladybugs between the months of May and July, depending on temperature. To be on the safe side, be sure to call ahead!
